TO HELP MAKE YOUR SRC EXPERIENCE GREAT!

01


We are switching things up this year and offering TWO separate sign up dates: one for July programs and one for August programs. This will mean we can accommodate more children and you need not worry about heading off on vacation! One thing to remember is that just because you have signed up for July you are not guaranteed a spot for August as well. You will need to sign up again in July for August SRC programs. Sign up dates are June 21st (for July) and July 19th (for August).

Spaces fill up VERY quickly. The quickest, easiest way to ensure registration is successful is to enter your information online. Please understand that at times this process can be busy and slowed down due to the high volume of registrations taking place.

Please register your child in the appropriate group. Children MUST be 3 years of age at the time of the program starting and MUST be potty-trained. The group your child attends is the grade in which they have JUST completed as of June 2019. The reason for this is that programs are designed for the grade levels indicated (Pre-School, Kindergarten - Grade 1, Grade 2 - Grade 4, and Grade 5+) and we want each child to enjoy the program as much as possible. For example: a child who has completed Pre-School registers in Pre-School, NOT K-1



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Children **MUST** have a library card in order to attend. The SRC staff and Library collect library card numbers on registration forms solely for the purpose of double checking that the child has a valid card. This is **NOT** intended to act as a replacement for a physical card. Children must bring physical cards to the program in order to ensure a quick, accurate, and enjoyable check out process.

SRC staff and Library staff are not responsible for reminding parents or caregivers of program times and dates. Once a participant registers they must note the date and time of their program. With over 150 children attending, calling each participant is simply not feasible. If you have a question about dates or times, please do not hesitate to call the Library at (250) 365-6611 to double check.

The SRC Facebook is the best way to stay in contact with the SRC coordinators throughout the summer months. This page is updated regularly and is a source of important dates, events, and program cancellations. Important information is also distributed through physical newsletters handed out throughout the program.
